- II. Call to Order- Colin Chambers
- III. Financial Report- Tim Perkins- We are currently at about 10,000 dollars for the year. Colin Chambers- We got the encampment bills this past week and ended up getting charged 3000 dollars for food at the cafeteria for the week before school started. Rick and I will meet with Fred Vocke this week to see if this can be resolved. Please email me the rough estimate of how much you actually ate in the cafeteria that week. Andrew Eaton- How much did we spend on encampment? Tim Perkins- about 7000-8000 dollars. 5,500 dollars on the actual weekend without the cafeteria bill. Andrew Eaton- I think that is way too much to spend on Encampment, more than years past. Past years we've had about 18000 dollars left over after encampment. Colin Chambers- In past years we haven't spent both nights at the hotel, we had bigger budgets, and I think we actually had 7000 dollars carry over last year from the year before.
