Parents need to select the level that best fits their child's ability. If the child is placed in the wrong level the swim instructors will adjust the class during the first class period.

Level I: Introduction to Water Skills

- 5:30-6:00 p.m. \$40.00
- 4 years old and up
- Class Size: Four children per instructor

This class is for children who are having their first experiences in or around the pool. Children learn to open their eyes underwater, submerge their mouth, eyes, and nose, blow bubbles, and float on their front and back with support.

Level II: Fundamental Aquatic Skills

- 5:30 - 6:15 p.m. \$45.00
- 5 years old and up
- Class Size: Six children per instructor

This class is for children who are comfortable in the water but still need to refine basic skills. Children learn to glide and float on their front and back, tread water, explore swimming on their side, front and back using combined strokes.

Dates, Times, and Prices

Level III: Stroke Development

- 6:15 - 7:00 p.m. \$45.00
- 6 years old and up
- Class Size: Six children per instructor

The Level III class is for children who can perform basic skills in the water and are ready to learn formal strokes. Children will learn rotary breathing, front crawl, back crawl, jumping into deep water, and diving from a sitting or kneeling position.

Level IV: Stroke Improvement

- 6:15 - 7:00 p.m. \$45.00
- 6 years old and up
- Class Size: Seven children per instructor

The Level IV class is for children who can already perform several swimming strokes. The class will develop confidence in learned skills and improve other swimming skills. Children will learn to use safe diving rules, dive from stride or compact position, swim underwater, swim breaststroke, elementary backstroke, and swim on their side using a scissor kick.

Level V: Stroke Refinement

- 5:30 - 6:15 p.m. \$45.00
- 7 years old and up
- Class Size: Eight children per instructor

This class is for children who can already swim the full length of the pool unassisted. Children will refine technique and endurance in six different swimming strokes. Children must show that they can complete all exit assessments of the Level IV Class to participate in the Level V Class.
