Directions – Complete this form to be considered for the Federal Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant program. The TEACH Grant provides up to \$4,000 per year in grants to students who commit to teach: 1) full-time; 2) in high-need subject areas; 3) for at least four out of the first eight years of teaching; and 4) at schools that serve students from low-income families.

If the commitment is not fulfilled, the grant is permanently converted to a loan to be repaid by the recipient. The loan is a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan with interest calculated from the time of the grant disbursement.

After meeting the William Jewell College TEACH grant requirements, you will be directed to complete Federal TEACH Grant counseling and the TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve and Promise to Pay.
