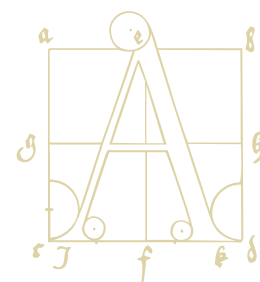

Greetings from “the Hill”



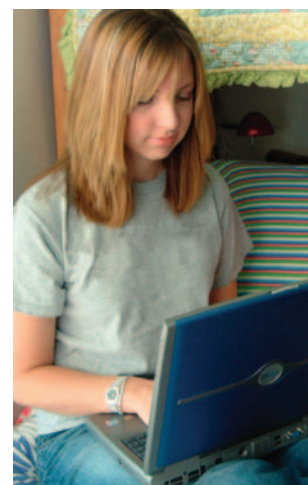

We can't wait to see our first-year students on campus finally as Jewell students. We enrolled an outstanding class, thanks in large part to your assistance during the college selection process.

The Entering Class of 2006

The quality of our incoming class once again represents some of the top students in the country. Our incoming first-years have an average GPA of 3.69 and 66% of our students graduated in the top 25% of their class. The middle 50% of this group scored from a 22 to a 28 on the ACT. We're also excited about the 69 students who scored a 28 or higher on their ACT and the 23 who were Valedictorian or Salutatorian of their class.

A complete application for admission includes an essay and activities résumé both of which can be submitted as a part of the online application. Students will also need to submit a Secondary School Report completed by their high school guidance counselor, along with their transcript including ACT and/or SAT scores.



Important Dates

December 1 Application Priority Date

Students who complete applications by December 1st will receive an admission decision before Christmas and receive priority for housing and scholarships.

January 19 Competitive Scholarship Deadline

Students who wish to be invited to our Scholar Recognition Days and considered for a competitive scholarship must have their application completed by this day.

March 1 Priority Filing Date for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid

Filing the FAFSA by this date will ensure awarding of maximum need-based aid for which a student qualifies.

May 1 National Candidate Reply Date

Students notify colleges under consideration of their intent to enroll.
