*All resident students (except seniors) are required to purchase a meal plan. Only commuter students and seniors are eligible for commuter meal plans.*

## Residence Hall Descriptions

### Browning Hall

Browning is an upper-class co-ed hall with some single occupancy rooms. The hall houses about 127 residents with separate key access for men and women. Each room has a sink and medicine cabinet/mirror. The bathrooms are community (shower stalls), located on each wing of the building.

### Eaton Hall

The first-year men's hall, Eaton houses about 142 men. Mostly double occupancy rooms, there are also two 4-person rooms. The bathrooms are community (shower stalls), located on each wing of every floor. Eaton and Ely are neighbors!

### Ely Hall

One of two first-year women's halls, Ely houses about 138 women. Mostly double occupancy rooms, there are also four 3-person rooms. The bathrooms are community (shower stalls), located on each wing of each floor. Ely and Eaton are neighbors!

### Senior House

Senior housing only, housing 50 residents. The building is co-ed, with separate key access for men and women. The bathrooms are community (shower stalls), located on each wing of each floor of the building.

### Melrose Hall

Melrose underwent a complete renovation in 2003! One of two first-year women's halls, Melrose houses about 75 women. The bathrooms are suite style, meaning two double-occupancy rooms are joined by a full bathroom to share among the four women.

### Semple Hall and Wing

An upper-class co-ed hall, Semple houses about 181 men and women. Semple is our largest facility and offers a significant number of single occupancy rooms. The bathrooms are community (shower stalls), located on each wing of every floor throughout the facility.
