Suggested Budget
2005-2006

William Jewell College will pay the program fee (tuition, room and board) for you and bill you for it. You will pay WJC. The other amounts are estimates suggested by program coordinators and students who have been abroad. This budget has been furnished to the Office of Student Financial Planning and will be used in calculating your need for financial aid awards. When you are planning your budget, remember that you would also have expenses if you were studying here on Jewell's own campus instead of overseas. Most students would spend at least \$2,000 per year (\$1,000 per semester) at WJC for books and supplies, personal items, entertainment, and transportation. So, not all overseas expenses are extra. NOTICE: if you plan to do a lot of additional travel, you may need extra funds.

² Student Rail Card \$30 (gives discount on rail use in UK)

² Student Bus Card For discounted travel among UK cities: \$16.50 with National Express; you may want to compare to Stagecoach. For travel within Oxford or Cambridge check the various city bus companies (e.g. Oxford has two), for passes that allow unlimited travel throughout Oxford or Cambridge (be sure to get the discounted student price!). Example price: \$80 for 13 weeks of unlimited travel in Oxford, with Oxford City bus.

² Bike purchase \$80-165 (can be sold at end of year, reducing the cost)
