GENERAL FRATERNITY VICE PRESIDENT DONALD G. (DIPPER) DIPAOLO *Michigan '78*

Donald G. (Dipper) DiPaolo, Ann Arbor, Michigan, was elected vice president of Beta Theta Pi General Fraternity in August 2002. He will serve a three-year term on the Board of Trustees.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Michigan, Dipper was an award-winning Saline High School teacher and coach for 19 years. He joined the University of Michigan School of Education faculty in 1997 as Cohort Director of the Master of Arts and Certification Program.

Dipper was Michigan chapter's house director (1992-95) and chapter counselor (1992-94) and served as district chief (1994-96) and regional director (1998) for the General Fraternity. He is a frequent speaker and advocate for Beta Theta Pi Fraternity's *Men of Principle* initiative and was a member of the 1996 Strategic Planning Committee.

Dipper is also nationally known as a strong advocate for quality fraternity and sorority life and spends much of his time on college campuses promoting interfraternalism. In August 2002, he was honored by the North-American Interfraternity Conference as recipient of the Award of Distinction, formerly known as the Ironman Award.
