- ___C. Gives directions that are clear, concise, and reasonable.
- ___D. Models effective verbal/non-verbal communication skills.
- ___E. Demonstrates sensitivity to cultural, gender, intellectual, and physical ability differences in classroom communication and in responses to students' communications.
- ___F. Uses a variety of media tools.

Standard 8: Assessment

Understands and uses formal and informal assessment strategies to evaluate and ensure the continuous intellectual, social, and physical development of the learner.

- ___A. Employs a variety of formal and informal assessment techniques (e.g. observation, portfolios of student work, teacher-made tests, performance tasks, projects, student self assessments, authentic assessments, and standardized tests) to enhance student progress and performances, and to modify instructional approaches and learning strategies.
