### **Jewell launches Greek Strategic Plan**

Members of William Jewell College's Greek Strategic Planning Committee will unveil the college's new Greek Strategic Plan at 8 p.m. October 3 in John Gano Memorial Chapel on the college campus in Liberty, Mo. Alumni and friends of the college are invited to attend the free event.

The October 3 event, "Honoring Our Past, Celebrating Our Future: 128 Years of Tradition," will provide the first public look at the college's new Greek Strategic Plan. The Greek Strategic Planning Committee was formed by Jewell's president Dr. David Sallee last spring to examine various issues related to Greek life at the college.

"William Jewell College and its Greek community are engaging in a historic partnership to enhance the rich traditions of Greek life at the college," said Rick Winslow, dean of students at William Jewell. "As a part of this partnership, both undergraduate and alumni members of the Greek community have joined faculty and community leaders to develop a Greek Strategic Plan. This plan combines shared goals designed to create a constantly evolving Greek experience more deeply grounded in the vision and core values of the Greek experience."

As a part of the planning process, Winslow said that committee members examined and reviewed the values and ideals upon which Greek life is built. "These core values of scholarship, leadership, service and a shared commitment to developing a quality living and learning experience were found to be entirely consistent with the mission of the college," Winslow added.

A free reception will be held in Yates College Union immediately following the program.
