Commuter Eligibility

- All students are required to live on campus, except when meeting one or more of the following conditions or exceptions:
1. senior status (90+ credit hours**), and not affiliated with a Greek organization;***
 2. six (6) chronological semesters completed** at full-time* status, and not affiliated with a Greek organization;***
 3. 23 years of age or older before August 1 of the academic year in question;
 4. married and/or have children and/or other legal dependents living with you;
 5. enrolled in less than 12 credit hours.

***19 meals/week	\$1,600	3 meals/day, M-F + 2 meals/day Sat-Sun	all resident students
***14 meals/week	\$1,505	2 meals/day, 7 days a week	all resident students
Commuter--5 meals/week	\$500	any 5 meals/week	commuters

Residence Hall Descriptions

Browning Hall

Browning is an upper-class hall with some private rooms, housing about 127. Each room has a sink and medicine cabinet/mirror. The building is co-ed, with men and women housed in separate wings. The bathrooms are community (shower stalls), located on each wing of the building.

Eaton Hall

The first-year men's hall, Eaton houses about 142 men. Mostly double occupancy rooms, there are also two 4-person rooms. The bathrooms are community (shower stalls), located on each wing of every floor. Eaton and Ely are neighbors!

Ely Hall

One of two first-year women's halls, Ely houses about 138 women. Mostly double occupancy rooms, there are also four 3-person rooms. The bathrooms are community (shower stalls), located on each wing of each floor. Ely and Eaton are neighbors!

Jones Hall

Jones is an upper-class building housing 41. The building is co-ed, with men and women housed in separate wings. The bathrooms are community (shower stalls), located on each wing of each floor of the building.

Melrose Hall

One of two first-year women's halls, Melrose houses about 75 women. The bathrooms are suite style, meaning two double-occupancy rooms are joined by a full bathroom to share among the four women.

Sample Hall and Wing

Sample Hall is an upper-class building housing 181. The building is co-ed, with men and women housed in separate wings. The bathrooms are community (shower stalls), located on each wing of every floor throughout the facility. Sample is our largest facility and offers a significant number of single occupancy rooms.
