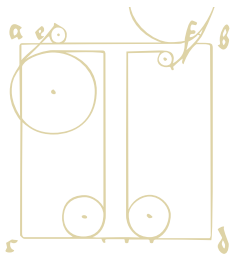


Are you ready to open a window to the world?
