<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.50 or higher (on a 4.0 scale)(the <i>minimum</i> GPA of 2.50 does not guarantee admission to the program) • Grade of C or better in all prerequisite courses. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Official college transcripts from all colleges attended • Completed application to William Jewell College • Completed Nursing supplement • Application deadline is August 1 of the year prior to the May term for which you are applying
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A BA or BS (or higher) degree from an accredited institution completed by December of the year prior to beginning program in May • A written summary of any community, volunteer or health-related experience • Completion of the A2 Reading Comprehension Test (\$25) administered by the Department of Nursing 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two letters of recommendation (academic or professional) that address the candidate’s character and ability to complete an intensive course of study • An interview with a member of the Department of Nursing • Candidates are considered on the basis of GPA, completed prerequisites, interview, letters of recommendation, and healthcare and volunteer experience
