By submitting a summer housing application/contract, I hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

- I agree to pay the \$600 per four (4) week session housing fee (or \$150/week), which will be billed to my student account. This stipulation does not apply to seniors with 90 earned credit hours by the end of the second summer session.
- I understand that the College does not provide a meal (board) plan to summer residents.
- I agree to abide by all campus and residence life policies and procedures as outlined in the *William Jewell College Student Handbook and Survival Guide*.
- I understand that I will not be able to check in before the designated opening date and time.
- I will vacate my summer residence hall room by the designated closing date and time.
- I understand summer housing placement is the sole discretion of the Office of Student Affairs and placements are made on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- I understand it is likely I'll have a summer roommate and this decision is based on demand for summer housing. Private rooms, if available, will be prioritized in the following order:
 1. full-pay summer students
 2. seniors
 3. other summer residents in the order their application is received
- I understand that this application only becomes contractually binding upon approval by the designated administrator with the Office of Student Affairs. Applicants will be contacted by the Office of Student Affairs.
