ORC Update

As a reminder of isolation and quarantine protocols, this [exposure matrix](#) is provided for clarity. There are 3 cases in isolation this week (1 will release this weekend) and 11 in quarantine, the majority of which are doing so off campus. Testing results for the week were 2 positives out of 50 (4%).

As announced last week, the College has antigen tests available. Students should visit the Student Health Center, employees should visit Campus Safety (Curry 124). Please see the September 30 email announcement for details.

Due to feedback from recent indoor activities with high numbers of visitors unfamiliar with College policies, some indoor events will require masking of all spectators, including vaccinated individuals, and the venue will post as such. If you are not currently doing so, please carry a facial covering at all times to comply. Disposable masks will be available as necessary.

The current ORC Level remains at A-2. Cases in [Clay County](#) have dropped to their lowest point since mid-July, even with higher [testing levels](#) than July.
